

Region 8 International Student Competition 2025

The Associated Schools of Construction (ASC) Region 8 International Student Competition 2025 hosted by the School of Surveying & Construction Innovation, TU Dublin opened on Wed 5th Nov 2025.

Hosted at The Iveagh Garden Hotel with over 200 people in attendance, the competition saw 22 teams, 17 of these being mixed International Collaborative formations from 15 European, UK and American Universities. This year saw the competition expand to include a new fourth competition track Sustainable Valuation and Development alongside the existing tracks: Construction Management & Quantity Surveying, Project Management and Design & Build.

The event brought together over 120 top construction management and built environment students from around the world to showcase their skills and knowledge.

All teams were presented with a real-life construction industry project in each track, where they were asked to prepare and present strategic contributions covering key project elements such as: Construction Programme, Site Strategy, Layouts and Logistics, Risk and Quality Management, and Estimating to name only some. Each team then had the opportunity to present their findings to the industry expert panel; this was then followed by an in-depth Q&A session. The competition closed on the 7th of Nov 2025 with the awards reception taking place in the Four-Star Iveagh Garden Hotel, Dublin 2.
